Date range problem when merging specific range from branch to trunk. Deleting Log Caches has no effect, Problem Persists across machines and reboots.

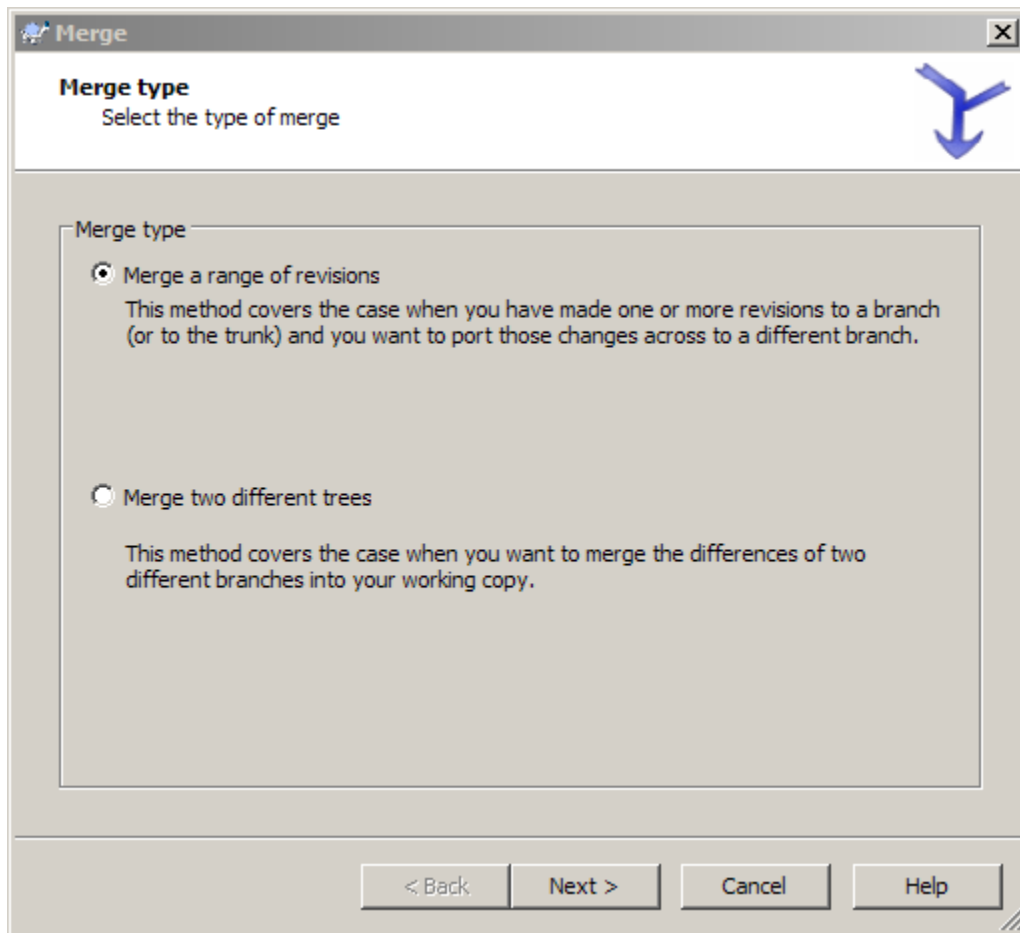
Platform and Version:

Repro steps:

1. Select "Merge..." from TortoiseSVN context menu.
2. Click "Next >"



3. Click "Show log"

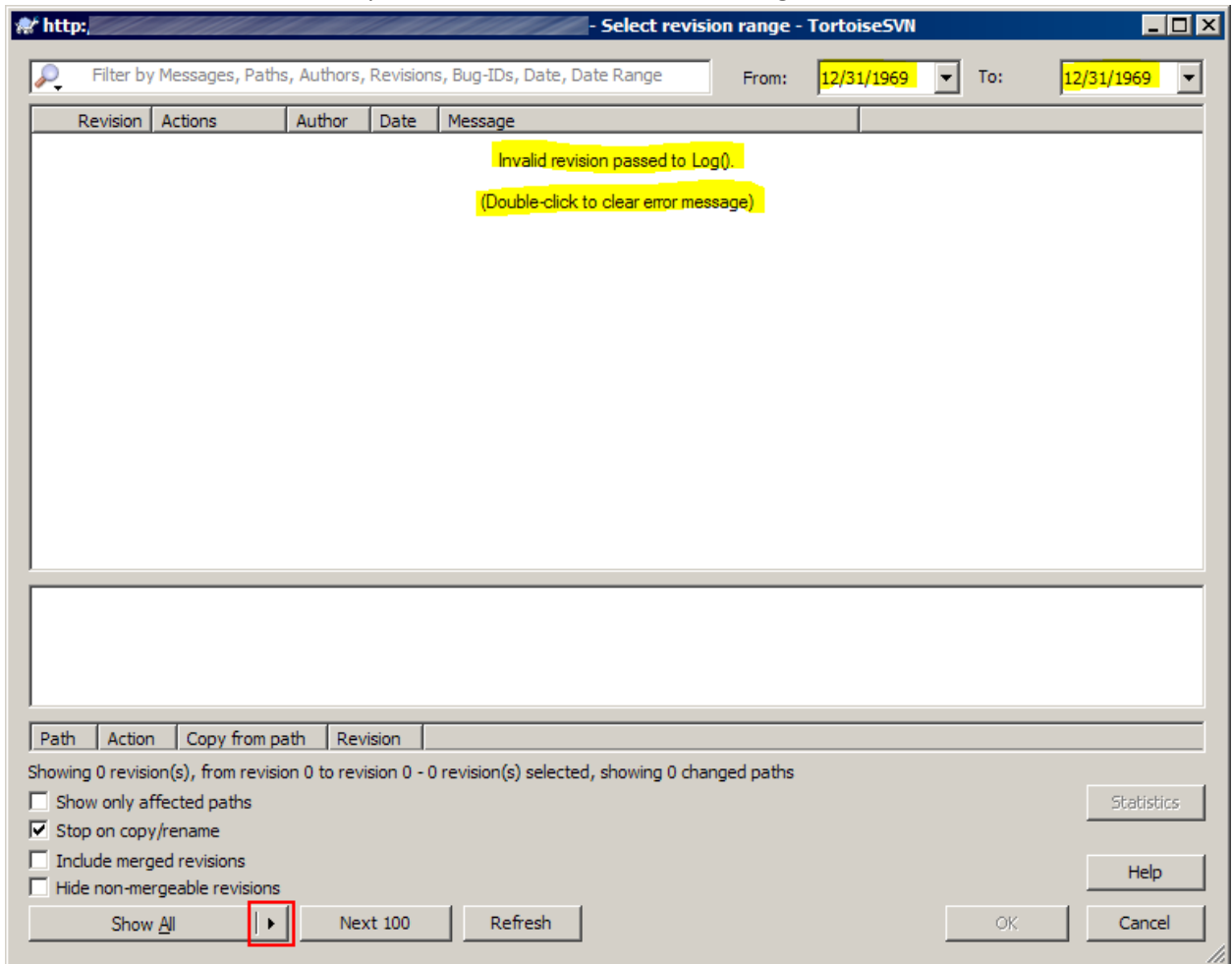

To merge all revisions (reintegrate/automatic merge), leave the box empty.

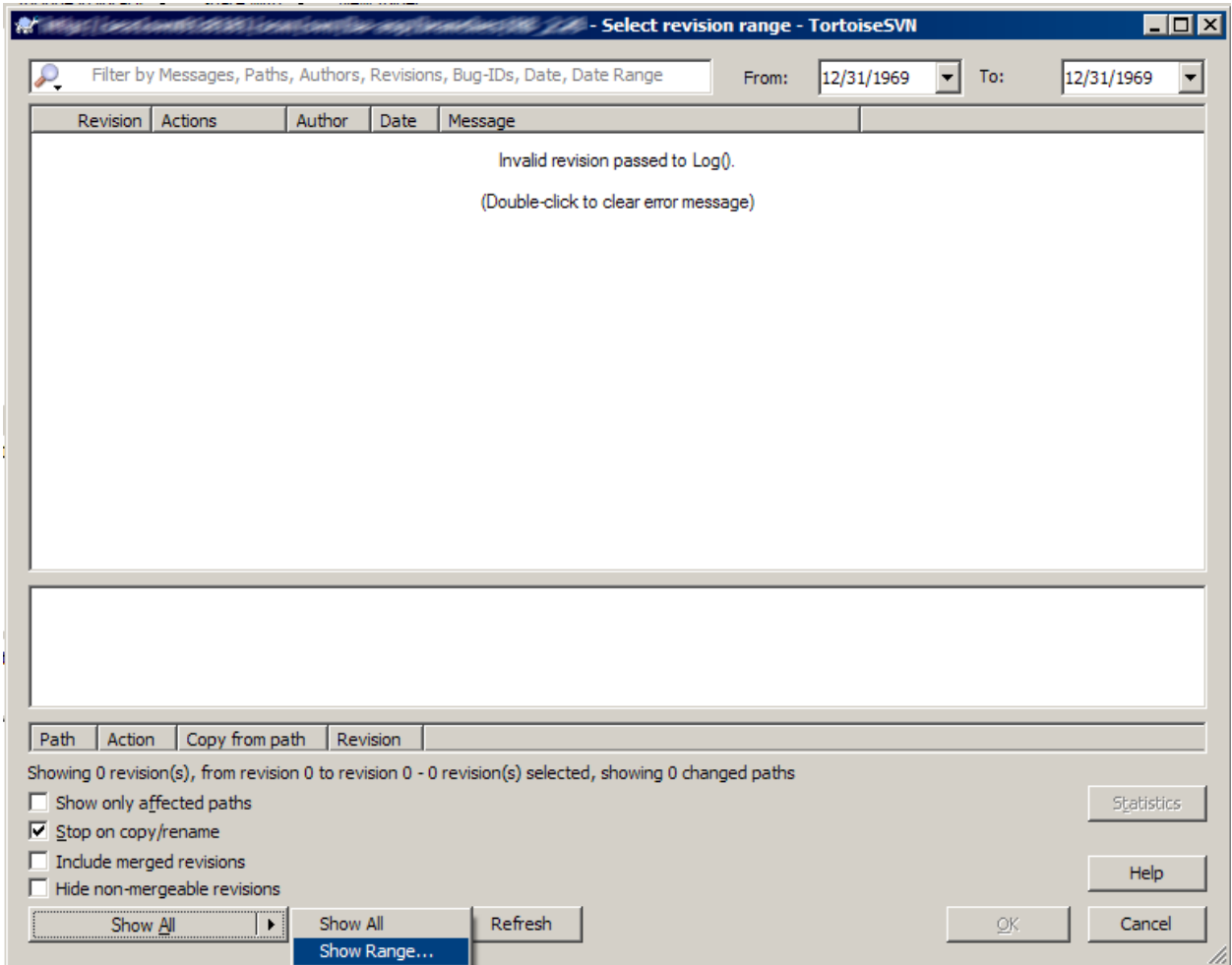
